Your pet is scheduled for anesthesia and/or surgery. Every general anesthetic procedure involves some risk to the patient. To minimize this risk, an IV Catheter is placed for additional safety for your pet. The cost of the IV Catheter is \$24.00. We also recommend a pre-anesthetic blood profile be performed in order that we may maximize patient safety and alert the doctor to the presence of dehydration, anemia, infection, kidney, and/or liver disease which could complicate the procedure. These conditions may not be detected unless a pre-anesthetic profile is performed. These tests are similar to those your own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia. State of the art equipment enables us to perform the pre-anesthetic blood profile within the hospital, and we are committed to making technology available to your pet. All pets are monitored using a pulse oximeter and are maintained on Isoflurane or Sevoflurane, the safest and most advanced anesthetics available. In addition, the induction agent propofol provides safe, quick, and smooth induction and recovery. Thermacare (warm air blanket) is used on all major surgeries to insure the proper body temperature is maintained.

Pre-Anesthetic Profile includes a CBC and a check of liver and kidney functions. The cost of this test is \$63.50.
